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Notice of Required Specifications for all LiveScan devices

December 1, 2008

To All Nevada LiveScan Vendors:

The purpose of this notice is to inform LiveScan vendors operating in the State of the mandated specifications required for all LiveScan devices installed currently or in the near future prior to the deployment of our "New" Store & Forward equipment. Our new Store and Forward will be implemented to both our criminal arrest and civil applicant systems in early 2009. It is crucial that Nevada vendors update and maintain current LiveScan devices to the exact specifications included in the WIN-EFTS, last updated in 2007, and the Nevada Specs, recently revised on November 26, 2008, and when necessary, especially for changes to an entity's fingerprinting needs. These specification documents have been previously provided to current Nevada vendors in an electronic file and are also available upon request from the Fingerprint Technician Unit Supervisors (hereafter referred to as "DPS LiveScan Coordinators") referenced below.

This notification is a courtesy to allow current Nevada LiveScan vendors time to ensure compliance as noted above and make any necessary changes to the LiveScan devices you may have in service prior to the deployment of our new Store & Forward. A deployment schedule will be distributed during the testing phase of our new Store & Forward with tentative implementation dates by vendor and agency based on the following priorities of the State:

- Law Enforcement Agencies
- State Agencies
- IBT Channeling Services
 - Pilot/Non-State Agencies
 - Pilot/Private Sector, including Fingerprinting Services
 - Agencies currently submitting to DPS-Identix Box

Integrated Biometric Technology LLC (IBT) will handle all non-state agencies and the private sector so the Nevada DPS will only have to work with one transfer to our new Store & Forward equipment. **IBT anticipates making their channeling service available to the private sector and non-state agencies beginning in January 2009 and prioritizing the Health Bureau's Pilot Agencies before taking on new businesses.**
